## Personal Responsibility and Liberty

## Rule of Law

- \* School Behaviour policy – all stakeholders are aware of the policy and it is understood and followed.
- \* Pupils have regular opportunities to reflect e.g. learning, their behaviour, during collective worship
- \*Pupil interviews on behaviour
- \* Parent / carers questionnaires relating to behaviour, safety etc
- \*School building links with local police.
- \*Collective worship with a focus linked to the law e.g. school rules, living in a multi-cultural society
- \* Understanding of consequences when rules are broken
- \* Visits from authorities such as the Police; Fire Service
