### Vocabulary

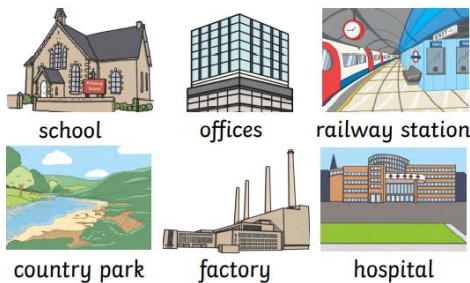
- Local area - the area around where you live. We live in Wyke.
- Map - a drawing of an area shown from above.
- Address - the place where someone lives, or a business is found.
- Observe - to watch/look at something carefully.
- Aerial view- what something would look like from above, looking down.
- Physical feature - a feature that has been formed by nature. E.g., a mountain.
- Human feature - a feature that has been made or changed by humans. E.g., a bridge or a train track.
- Landmark - a well known building or place (e.g., Judy woods)
